

Thank you for your interest in Rivertown Assisted Living. We have a unique program that incorporates community-based home care services and affordable housing rental assistance. The Detroit Housing Commission is processing your application for an apartment in our community. Rivertown Assisted Living offers private apartments to older adults ages 62 and up who need home care services with two or more activities of daily living to maintain independence. Those services are provided by an on-site service provider.

Individuals moving to Rivertown assisted living must have resources to pay for needed personal care and health related services. The Detroit Area Agency on Aging - Mi choice Waiver Program, Program of All-inclusive Care of the Elderly (PACE) and some Veteran Administration benefits are examples of programs that help pay for and support older adults living at Rivertown. Enrollment in a program must be approved and in place before we can complete the move in process. If you are not already enrolled in a program that provides home care assistance, please contact one of the above agencies for enrollment assistance and information.
